VACATION/PROFESSIONAL LEAVE POLICY
2012-2013**

Vacation

The Emory vacation policy is 15 workdays. Vacation should generally be proportional to the length of the rotation. Vacation/Professional Leave forms must be sent to us a minimum of 1 month prior to the vacation. The vacation/professional leave forms are posted on the Psychiatry Website (<http://www.psychiatry.emory.edu/PoliciesandForms.htm>) as well as on Blackboard. You will be informed via email once the vacation has been approved.

Professional Leave

There is the potential to approve up to five working days of professional leave for residents at the PGY-2 level and above. PGY-1s are allowed up to 3 professional leave days on the Psychiatry service if they are attending a professional meeting and receiving an award or presenting a paper/abstract.. Vacation/Professional Leave forms must be sent to us a minimum of 1 month prior to the vacation. The vacation/professional leave forms are posted on Blackboard. You will be informed once the professional leave has been approved.

Process

1. First, the resident should talk to their attending and chief resident regarding the vacation/professional leave request.
2. The resident should then email, or fax or bring their vacation/professional leave form to the Residency Education Office.
3. Our office will send the form to the appropriate attending(s) to obtain approval per the chart below. The request will be sent to the “Approval” recipients and copied to the resident and the “Inform” recipients.
4. The “Approval” recipient will send us an email indicating if the request was granted or denied.
5. Our office will send an email to the resident and copy the “Approval” and “Inform” recipients to inform you your vacation/professional request has been granted or denied.

PGY-2 Vacation Policy

The Chief Residents at Emory and the VA will be in charge of assigning vacation time. The Chief Residents will decide on how they will take requests and determine who will get vacation during each period but the result will be that the residents may take one continuous five day Monday through Friday week of vacation for each 6 month block. This week will be decided at the beginning of the block, assigned by the Chief Resident and will take into account spreading the vacation time across rotation sites so that one rotation site will have no more than one week for each month of the rotation averaged over the year. This means that if the two month VA inpatient rotation had two residents take week long vacations in the first half of the year then no

residents would be assigned to take a one week vacation on the VA inpatient rotation in the second half of the year.

Each resident would therefore have 2.5 vacation days left for each 6 month block given that they have 15 vacation days a year. The residents would be able take an additional 2-3 days of vacation in each 6 month block. This will be allotted using the old system of requesting time off from the attending and getting their approval. The residents would be required to take at least 2 additional days off on the first 6 month block.
