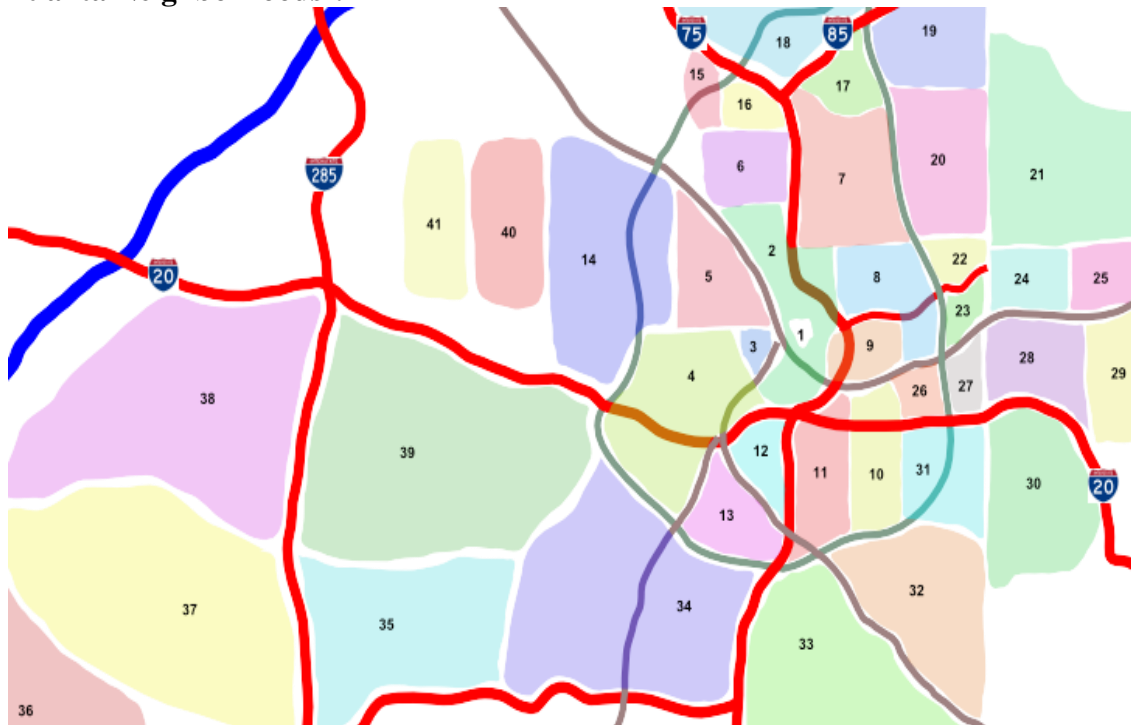

## **Popular Areas Where Residents Live:**

### **7 Midtown**

Distance from Grady: 10-15 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 10-15 minutes  
Cost: \$\$ range from 750-1000 for one bedroom apartment  
Attractions: Arts Center of Atlanta. Home of the Fox Theater, High Museum of Art, and Alliance Theater. Walking distance from several restaurants and popular lounges.

### **21 Druid Hills**

Distance from Grady: 15 – 20 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 5-10 minutes  
Cost: \$\$-\$\$\$ from 750-1000 for one bedroom apartment  
Attractions: Close to Emory, Piedmont Park, many quiet outdoor shopping districts. Many suburban neighborhoods and great bike paths.

### **20 Virginia Highlands**

Distance from Grady: 10 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 10 minutes  
Cost \$\$-\$\$\$ from 750-1200 for one bedroom apartments  
Attractions: Historic Atlanta. Great area for dining! Many unique boutiques. A laid back area with a wide diversity of people.

### **23 Inman Park and Little Five Points**

Distance from Grady: 10 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 15-20 minutes  
Cost: \$\$ from 800-1200 for one bedroom apartments  
Attractions: Little Five is unique for its alternative shops and restaurants including The Vortex, Flying Biscuit and Junkman's Daughter. Inman Park is a quaint area adjacent to Little Five Points. Part of historic Atlanta, now has many new apartments and many renovated homes.

### **2 Downtown**

Distance from Grady: 5-10 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 15 -20 minutes  
Cost: \$\$-\$\$\$ from 750-1200 for one bedroom apartment  
Attractions: Close to Grady. Home of Phillips Arena, the Georgia Dome, Georgia State University, the Georgia Aquarium, and World of Coca-Cola.

### **18 Buckhead**

Distance from Grady: 15-20 minutes by interstate  
Distance from Emory: 20 – 30 minutes  
Cost: \$\$\$ range from 850-1300 for one bedroom apartment  
Attractions: Minutes from Lenox Mall and Phipps Plaza, dozens of boutiques, and fine dining restaurants.

### **16 Atlantic Station**

Distance from Grady: 10 minutes  
Distance from Emory: 25 minutes  
Cost: \$\$\$ range from 900+ for one bedroom apartment  
Attractions: Atlantic Station is a new area to Atlanta just off of 75/85. A city within the city, walking distance to grocery, shopping, dining.
